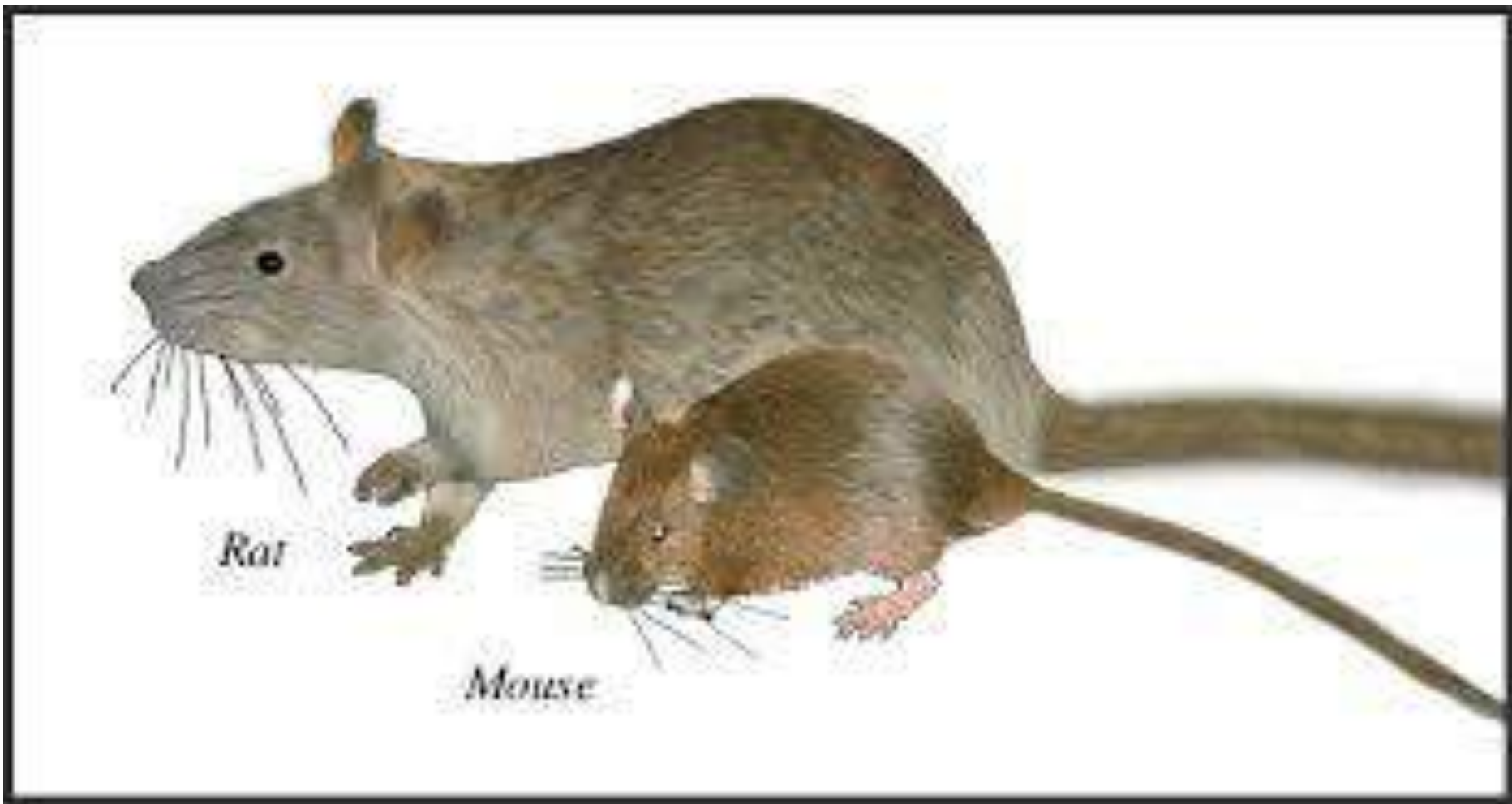

Rat and Mouse

The most distinctive Characters of Brown rat

- 1. Rats are macrofauna**
- 2. They are Multicellular animals**
- 3. The body covered by hairs.**
- 4. The body consist of four parts haed, neck, trank and tail.**

- 5. Rats have thicker body and weigh 300-400 gm.**
- 6. Tail shorter than length of head & body**
- 7. They have Small hairy ears**
- 8. They have Blunt nose**

Brown rat

The most distinctive Characters of House mice

- 1. Mice are macrofauna**
- 2. They are Multicellular animals**
- 3. The body covered by hairs.**
- 4. The body consist of four parts haed, neck, trank and tail.**

- 5. House mice measure 12 to 20 cm in length, including the tail, and weigh 12 to 30 grams.**
- 6. Mice have large, floppy ears**
- 7. They have long, thin, hairy tails.**
